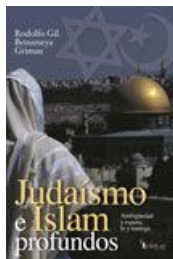


Judaísmo e islam profundos : ambigüedad y espera, fe y entrega
