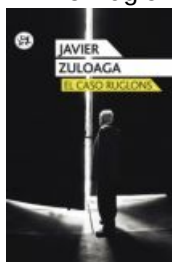

Maruja Sanz is a young girl of humble origins from Valgonzález, a small Castilian town near Segovia.
