Making use of collage, Rocío Araya manages to perfectly incorporate the artwork created by children from Thille Boubacar (Senegal) into her own illustrations. Some of the original drawings are included at the end of the book and readers are invited to find them in the main story. There book also includes a brief glossary of words in Fula, the language of the protagonist of this simple, captivating story about emigration and losing touch.
