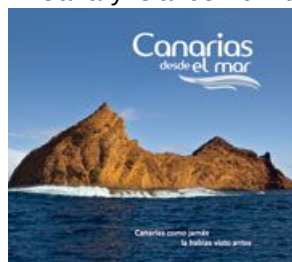


Canarias desde el mar
